### *Marc N. Andrukiewicz*



*Marc N. Andrukiewicz* is vice president of Operations for Yankee Gas Services Company, a subsidiary of the Northeast Utilities system. In this role, he is responsible for Yankee Gas operations, engineering, construction and maintenance.

From August 2007, Andrukiewicz served as director of Construction for Yankee Gas and The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P), where he was responsible for construction projects involving betterment of natural gas main and service installations, overhead electric lines, underground electrical networks, and substations.

Andrukiewicz joined Northeast Utilities in 1980 as a project engineer in the Nuclear Engineering and Operations group overseeing construction betterment projects at NU's nuclear power plants. In 1984, he became staff engineer with CL&P's Gas group. In 1989, when Yankee Gas was divested from Northeast Utilities, he was an engineering supervisor in Field Operations. He held various managerial positions of increasing responsibility in Yankee Gas' Operations, Gas Supply and Sales and Marketing departments, as well as with Yankee Energy's former unregulated subsidiary, YESCo. He was project director for the construction of Yankee Gas' largest construction project involving the building of the LNG plant in Waterbury.

He holds a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Hartford, and in 1990 earned a Master's of Business Administration from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. He is a licensed professional engineer in the State of Connecticut.

Andrukiewicz serves on the Board of Directors for Junior Achievement of Southwest New England.
